A girl from Birmingham who is confined to a wheelchair because of a genetic disorder has been given a holiday thanks to a charity.

Rapid Effective Assistance for Children with potentially Terminal illness (React) sent nine-year-old Laura Postlethwaite and her family to Devon.

Laura lives with a Complex Chromosomal Anomaly – Partial Trisomy 13 with Kyphoscoliosis which means she is totally dependant on her parents for all her care needs. From the age of 16 months she has been in a wheelchair.
